MONEY

PROVERBS 9:10–11

Understanding money is no simple task, but there is wisdom in God about everything in everyday life. Seek Jesus and his Kingdom and God shall provide for you (*Matthew 6:25–34*). Please God with your true faith in him, and his heart shall be touched. (*Hebrews 6:11; Matthew 17:2*)

CORRUPTION

Corruption kills. Everything that is born in the mind of a doer can be killed by corruption, therefore no one reaps what they have sown. (*Philippians 4:15; Luke 16:10–13*)

DANIEL 6:1–4

It is so important to keep good track of all use of Money, and to never lack in bookkeeping. Doing so, you will always avoid economical corruption to creep into the congregation to destroy blessing of monetary value.

SUPPORT

Supporting one another is key in the loving relationships within the congregation. Whether it is helping each other with physical lack of something, or fellowship in community with someone. (*Ephesians 4:28; James 1:27, 2:14–18; 1 John 3:16–18*)

OFFERINGS

Offerings are submission to the will of Christ, whom he wants to reward and give everything they need. First of all, everyone needs the Bread of Life. Secondly, they need truth, the truth hidden in the scriptures. Therefore help each other to receive a copy of the bible. Each one of you should bring a small offering, by making a wise decision personally, not under compulsion, but with joy in the heart, so that other people could receive the Word of God.
